

Colour in this funny picture of Claude and his new friend from the country!










In the Spotlight

Sir Bobblysock has unravelled himself! Can you follow his woolly trail and see which thread is connected to Claude?










Create your own movie poster.


- Decide what your movie is going to be about: is it a monster movie, a mermaid movie, an alien movie, or something else?
